- o **Flexibility and Multidisciplinary Approach**: He discussed how NEP 2020 encourages interdisciplinary learning, allowing students to choose subjects based on their interests, promoting holistic education.
- Assessment Reforms: Prof. Vernekar emphasized the need for assessment reforms that focus more on students' conceptual understanding rather than rote learning.

- Skill Development and Vocational Training: He highlighted the importance of equipping students with practical skills for employability, as emphasized by NEP 2020.
- Teacher Training and Capacity Building: He pointed out that NEP 2020 includes provisions for teacher training and development to ensure the quality of education is enhanced.
